**Thank you. Your regular support is a lifeline to the plants and animals that are under threat**

It's incredible to think what we have achieved with your help over these past few months, and I want to take a moment to share some of those highlights with you.

- Thanks to you, in April we introduced more than **50,000 native baby oysters** to Windara Reef, South Australia. We hope to build the reef to span 20 hectares across the seafloor, and **with every hectare of reef we restore, five more tonnes of fish will be drawn to the reef each year**
- Your help meant we could launch *Living Melbourne: our metropolitan urban forest*. This strategy marks the first time in Australia that a vast area of a city has been mapped to understand where trees exist, and what can be done to **protect and expand urban forests**
- Because of your support, the **endangered Murray Hardyhead fish was reintroduced to wetlands**. This was thanks, in part, to our unique water fund, which supplied much needed water to wetlands to aid the return of the fish to Murray River waters in NSW - for the first time in more than a decade

These are huge achievements, which would not be possible without you. But while we've made some great strides forward, it's more important than ever before to keep pursuing our mission.

The recent United Nations biodiversity report reminds us that "**One million species are at risk of extinction**". More than half a million species on land "have insufficient habitat for long-term survival" and are **likely to go extinct**, many within decades, unless the destruction stops and their habitats restored. And, sadly, the story is no different in our oceans.

**These are not small challenges. But if we each do our part, solving them is possible.** With your generous support and our conservation expertise, we can make a difference on a massive scale.

I'm so grateful for your support – thank you for being the passionate, committed person you are. You are the reason we can have hope for a better future.
